National Tuberculosis Elimination Program (NTEP) The Joint Director informed the house that around 1324 cases are reported to be presumptive TB as per examination in the district.

The Joint Director further informed the house that:

- T.B Notification (Public and Private) for the year 2025 is 83. Out of which till January, 47 has been achieved which is 56.4%.
- Upfront NAAT Test till January 2025 is 727.
- 35 no. of patients has been provided differentiated TB care as on 5th March against the total number of 90 patients.

Nikshay Mitra

The total number of patients on treatment under Nikshay Mitra as on 6th March 2025 is 82 in the district.

The Joint Director further informed the house that:

- All TB patients in Chirang are receiving food baskets under the Nikshay Mitra program. This support has been fully covered by BGR, ensuring comprehensive nutritional aid.
- 13 Bolero **NEO** ambulances have been provided by BGR to serve hard-to-reach hospitals rural in Chirang. This has significantly improved patient transport and emergency care access.
