

## Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)

(Har Ghar Jal)



### Vision:

Every rural household must have drinking water supply in adequate quantity (55 liters per capita per day, LPCD) of prescribed quality (**IS 10500-2012**) on regular and long-term basis at affordable service delivery charges leading to improvement in living standards of rural communities by 2024.

### Mission:

- i. States/UTs in participatory rural water supply strategy for ensuring potable drinking water security on long-term basis to every rural household and public institution, viz. GP/VCDC Building, School, Anganwadi centre, Health Centre, Wellness Centres etc.
- ii. States/UTs for creation of water supply infrastructure so that every rural household has Functional Tap Connection (FHTC) by 2024 and water in adequate quantity (55 LPCD) of prescribed quality is made available on regular basis.
- iii. GPs/VCDCs/ rural communities to plan, implement, manage, own, operate and maintain their own in-village water supply system etc.

### Objective:

- i. To provide Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC) to every rural household.
- ii. To monitor functionality of tap connections.
- iii. To promote and ensure voluntary ownership among local community by way of contribution in cash, kind and/or labour and voluntary labour (Shramdaan)
- iv. Infrastructure and funds for regular operation & maintenance etc.
