(a) Widely disseminate information regarding the award among all district-level departments, emergency response agencies, local bodies, civil defence units, community-based organisations and volunteers.

(b) Identify and encourage nomination of deserving individuals, district-level institutions, response teams and community initiatives that have demonstrated excellence in disaster management.

(c) Ensure that information about the award is placed on the district website and communicated through appropriate official channels for maximum outreach.

Instituted by the **Government of India**, the award seeks to highlight exemplary work and best practices that strengthen the country's capacity to prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from disasters.

The award recognises outstanding contributions across the entire spectrum of disaster management, including **prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response, relief, rehabilitation, reconstruction, research, innovation, early warning systems, community awareness, and capacity building**. It aims to encourage innovation, promote best practices, and inspire individuals, organisations and institutions to contribute actively towards building a safer and disaster-resilient India. By celebrating exceptional efforts in disaster risk reduction and humanitarian response, the award also helps in disseminating successful models and motivating wider participation in strengthening national disaster resilience.
