

**Minutes of the DLC Meeting under AAGY, 2018-19 held on 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 in the Conference Hall of the DC's Office, Chirang, Kajalgaon for discussion on the implementation of Schemes under AAGY.**

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Members present is at Annexure-A.

A meeting of District Level Committee was held on 08/02/2022 under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Chirang to discuss the ongoing implementation of various schemes taken under AAGY, 2018-19 at the four villages namely Amlaiguri, Rangijhora, Gargaon No.1 and Bhatopara of Chirang district.

At the outset, the Deputy Commissioner welcomed all the members present and initiated the discussion.

After threadbare discussion the following points emerged and decision were taken.

(1) Initiating the discussion, the Deputy Commissioner informed the house that 12 (twelve) nos. of Schemes have been implementing in the aforesaid four villages under the AAGY 2018-19 in respect of 31 Sidli (ST) LAC & 33 Bijni LAC areas. He also informed that as per the decision taken in the review meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2022 by the Hon'ble CM, for the work of inspection of the Entry Point Activities constructed in the model villages, a group of officers will be sent to each of the District by the respective Department within the month of February.

2) The Hon'ble MLA, 31-Sidli (ST) LAC suggested the house that apart from the existing schemes being implemented in the four villages, some important schemes on Sports activities, construction of School Building, Anganwadi centres etc. are to be taken for execution in the villages with a view to make a standard model village. He also requested the line Departments concerned to conduct a field visit in those villages and to consider such schemes by converging their departmental sources of fund.

3) While reviewing regarding Gram Sabha meeting convened in the Rangijhora village, the Chairman, Khungkhrajhora VDC, informed the house that the public are fully satisfied on the executed schemes. He also requested the Deputy Commissioner to pay a visit to Rangijhora Village and to consider other developmental schemes.


4) The BDO, Borobazar Development Block informed the house that there is an LP school namely No.220 Rangijhora LP School having both Assamese and Bodo medium. But, as, no Assamese language teacher is available at present in that school, he requested the Hon'ble MLA, 31-Sidli (ST) LAC to take up the matter and meet up the problem.

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5) The Deputy Commissioner, Chirang directed all BDOs of Sidli-Chirang, Borobazar and Manikpur Development Block to complete the Household Level Survey and to submit the report to the DC at the earliest. They will monitor and expedite the implementation of schemes as they are the Chairman of the VLC and Construction Committees. The DC also requested all BDOs and Head of the Departments to conduct field visits and to make programme for night halt for better understanding of the developmental issues at the notified villages. He urged all the line departments to take up works at the notified villages by converging their departmental source of fund. Specifically, the DC proposed and requested the concerned departments to take up schemes on sericulture, horticulture, pisciculture etc. in each of the notified villages and to develop any one of village located near to National Highway as a tourist attracted place. He also requested the BDOs to convene a meeting alongwith all the members of the VLC at their respective villages to discuss the various issues related to development and to submit their development plan to the District Administration.

6) Sri Kushal Kalita, ACS, Assistant Commissioner, Chirang requested all BDOs concerned to ensure early completion of the on-going schemes as the schemes were sanctioned/started during the financial year 2018-2019.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.


